The Question Matrix is used to formulate questions in a current topic. It can be used in any subject and in a variety of different ways. It allows students to be challenged and it also provides opportunity for personalised learning.



Get students to come up with questions by choosing a word from the left-most column followed by a word from the top row.

FOCUS:

Questioning

Get students to write down their questions on post-it-notes and stick them to the board.

Students can describe a variety of aspects of the photo through developing and asking quality questions and encouraging quality dialogue.

Examples:

- *What is...happening?
- *How could...this affect the future of the earth?
- *How will...this affect the Earth's atmosphere?
- *Why might... we be unaware that this is about to happen?
- *How might...humans survive?

Use learning structures to enable quality discussions about the questions students have posed.
