• **Tuesday 21st June** - all students will attend compulsory exam booster sessions from 9:25am until 12:00, they may then leave for home study or remain onsite for lunch 12:00 - 12:30pm. The students staying for lunch will then leave the site at 12:30pm.

 \cdot At 1:00pm students studying Hospitality and Catering will go for their exams. Students will then leave the site after their exams.

• Wednesday 22nd June - all students will attend compulsory booster sessions from 9:25 until1:30pm. • At 1:00pm students studying Further Maths will go for their exams. They will then leave the site after the exam.

 \cdot At 1:30pm all other students who are not taking part in the Further Maths exam will leave the academy site to continue their study at home.

• **Thursday 23rd June** - all students will attend from 8:00am for their Physics exam.

• From 11:15 until 1:00pm students will attend a Leavers' assembly and also get the opportunity to take part in the rites of passage. Students will then leave the academy site at 1:00pm.

Rites of passage

As we move towards more normal times we are keen to support students in their wishes to participate in rites of passage opportunities, as they celebrate their time at secondary school and their hard work at the end of exams. At 11:15 on Thursday 23rd June, students will be able to attend a leaver's assembly, sign shirts and books with each other and their teachers in the dining hall. **Students have already signed up for the prom and have placed deposits for the event on Thursday 30th June at OEC Sheffield**.
